WHEN: Saturday 11 – 1 will be sheep. Then 2 – 4 will be cattle. Sunday is one training class from 11 – 4. The classes will take place within a fenced in area, it does not mean totally dog escape proof.

Note – you or your dog will not be working livestock the full two hours or 5 hr sessions. The time is shared between the number of people that participate for that time period. We also will take a break between 1-2. Even though you may not work your dog the full amount of time, there will be times that the lesson just requires you to put time in and not your dog. Sometimes you may be working a more advanced dog to acquire skills before you work your own dog, helping out with another student and their dog or watching a demonstration of the skill we are working on. You will get multiple lessons on livestock throughout the lesson time frame.

CLASS FEE Saturday sheep fee- \$65. Saturday cattle fee \$80. Second Dog add \$40. Private Lesson \$150. Instinct Tests are \$25**. Pre-payment before first lesson is required. **Special discount - pay for three lessons and receive a complimentary fourth lesson! **Paypal at jean464creates@gmail.com NO REFUNDS unless I need to cancel and refunds will be made or transferred to the next lesson date...OR .. a replacement team can be found to take your place, and then you will get a refund. **Complimentary lessons do not include the stock rental fee per dog of \$10 per dog. First time students are encouraged to buy and read my book, Herding Primer. \$35 (plus tax) & Herding Foundations \$20. Herding Foundations is a detailed outline of the exercises we learn during the lessons.

Instinct tests are scheduled during Saturday's sheep training and last about 10-15 minutes.

Class may be cancelled due to lack of participants, extreme heat, wet weather, too muddy, too icy or some other unknown. Those classes will be made up at the next available Saturday. No refunds unless another dog/handler team is found to take your place. Make up classes can be arranged.

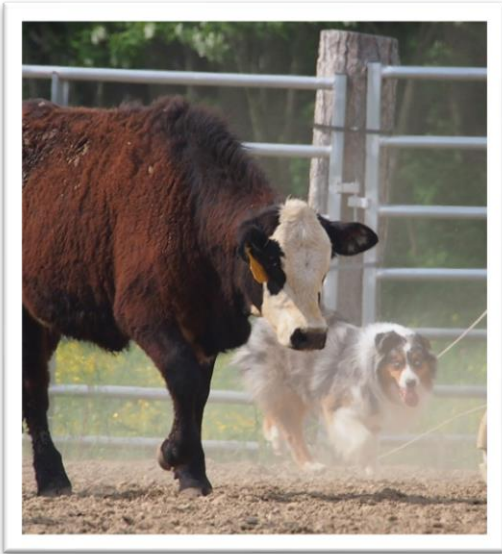
We will be working with sheep, cattle and/or ducks for these lessons. Ducks generally are a more fragile species, so greater care needs to be taken to ensure they are not physically damaged. Most importantly do not allow your dog to jump on, pounce, run through or de-feather them.

PAYMENTS: Can be made through PayPal, Venmo, Square, Check or cash.

RENTAL TIME: Livestock rental is available. A simple proficiency must be shown in order to have access to stock and fields. Expect supervision your first few times. Sheep \$25. Cattle \$35. Ducks \$15

WHAT TO BRING: The waiver, portable chair, and your dog. Water for you and your dog. Your typical training tools and food/toy treats. Plain buckle collar is fine. A leash of at least 6' long or longer. The leash should be thick enough to hold back your dog. No fine leather or nylon leashes that could break under strain or rip out of your hand easily. Gloves may be a good idea, too. I have some appropriate leashes to borrow if you do not.

WORKING LIVESTOCK: We will use care and diligence for the welfare of all dogs, persons and livestock, but will not be responsible for, nor assume liability in the event of an accident or misfortune, however caused to or by dogs, persons or property.

Working livestock can be a risk to both you and your dog(s). Injuries can happen at any time. Work the stock (sheep/ducks/cattle) at your own risk. Common but not limited to these types of injuries: knee and ankles – from stock running into people, to tripping over stock or uneven ground. Dogs can be injured as well, but not limited to - from running into fences, getting trampled, or from uneven footing. These are just some of the hazards that could take place.

REPLACEMENT POLICY: In the unlikely event of you or your dog(s) injuring or harming livestock, you are financially responsible for any vet bills & supplies needed to bring stock back to full health. In the event that this is not possible, YOU are still financially responsible for any vet bills & costs of disposing of body, PLUS a replacement cost of \$300 per sheep, \$60 per duck and market value for cattle - \$800 or more

I am aware that herding and activities involved with working stock may be a hazardous activity. I am voluntarily participating in these activities with the full knowledge of the potential danger involved. I hereby agree to accept any and all risk of injury to myself, my dog(s), or any dog(s) under my care, custody or control and verify this statement by placing my initials here: _____

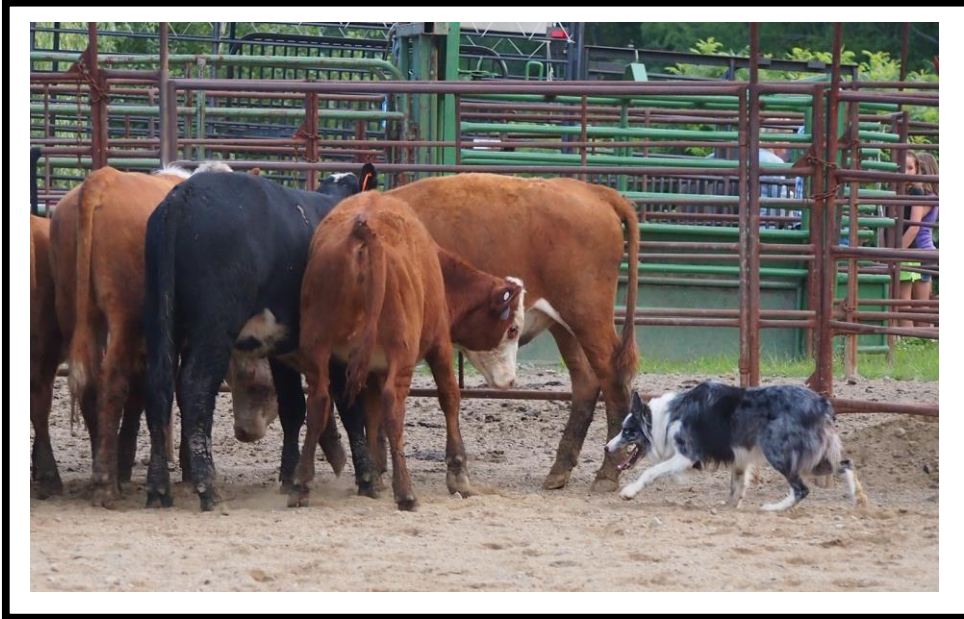

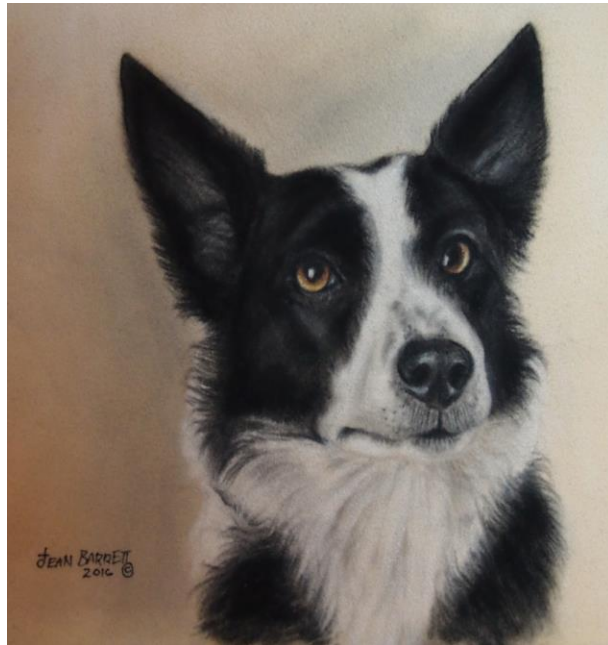
