We are going to do two days of Trial Learning Clinics!! We are set up to do Novice Field Trial and Arena Trials. Cappy will evaluate and provide you with helpful feedback on your runs – either field or arena. We will be working sheep for these days.

**June 1 & 2** will be the Learning Clinics. Participants should be at least a Started level ready to trial for arena and for field trials – competent at about 150'-300' outrun. We will have obstacles set up in the arena and a novice field course set up in the field...about 4.5 acres.

**June 3-4-5** will be the Sheep Herding Clinic – access to small pens, arena & fields will be available.

**June 7-8-9** will be the Cattle Herding Clinic – access to small pens & arena will be available.

All herding heritage breeds and mixes and levels welcomed! Dogs should be at least 8 months to a year or older to participate. No previous herding experience required for June 3-9.

June 1-9 / Sheep & Cattle. Hood's Farm is located in Ashville, NY, which is just a few minutes from the famous Chautauqua Institute on Chautauqua Lake. This is a resort area and hotels do book up in the summer. The farm is situated in the hills above the Lake. There are over 100 acres to this farm consisting of wooded and grassy areas. A few ponds are located all around the property. Dogs are allowed to go swimming in the pond nearest the working areas. Hood's Farm has over 300 hundred head of commercial sheep. This is a unique opportunity to work much larger groups of sheep then what is usually used in training. There are smaller training areas and larger open fields to train in. At the end of your run, feel free to walk along the trails or logging road. It is Amish Country and it is common to see horse & buggies all over this area.

**HOOD'S FARM - DIRECTIONS** 610 Wellman Road Ashville, NY OWNER is Courtney Hood. Access from either direction off Rte 17/86. Some gps units take down Big Tree Rd to Lawson Road and then a right onto Wellman. The barns will be across the street from that Stop Sign at Lawson Rd. If coming from the East – sometimes gps takes me down Wellman in which case the barns will be PAST the house (#747) on your Right – just before Lawson Road. I will have a herding sign out at the driveway.

Common but not limited to these types of injuries: knee and ankles – from stock running into people, to tripping over stock or uneven ground. Dogs can be injured as well, but not limited to - from running into fences, getting trampled, or from uneven footing. These are just some of the hazards that could take place.

**REPLACEMENT POLICY**: In the unlikely event of you or your dog(s) injuring or harming livestock, you are financially responsible for any vet bills & supplies needed to bring stock back to full health. In the event that this is not possible, YOU are still financially responsible for any vet bills & costs of disposing of body, PLUS a replacement cost of \$300 per sheep, \$60 per duck and market value for cattle - \$800 or more
